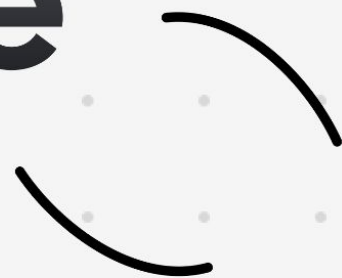

What authentication methods does the Confluence API support in very short.

Based on the search results, the Confluence API supports these authentication methods:

In short:

1. **Basic Authentication** - Username and password
2. **Personal Access Tokens** (available from Confluence Data Center 7.9+)
3. **Anonymous Access** - No authentication (limited permissions)
4. **OAuth 2.0** - For Cloud apps (with scopes or JWT bearer tokens)

Note: Authentication uses the same permissions as browser access - if you can't view something in the browser, you can't access it via the API.
